## Perfusion

Perfusion is the technology of organ preservation by the circulation of oxygenated blood outside the body, using a heart-lung bypass machine (also known as cardiopulmonary bypass). Virtually all heart operations require the services of a perfusionist to operate the heart-lung bypass machine. A perfusionist works with the cardiac surgeon and operates the bypass machine during heart surgery to maintain a safe and stable condition while the heart is stopped for repair. Perfusionists may operate such equipment during any medical situation where it is necessary to support or temporarily replace the patient's cardio pulmonary or circulatory function. The perfusionists main work is performed within a cardiac operating theatre, but they also work in intensive care units, orthopaedic, vascular and neurosurgical operating theartes and cardiac catheter laboratories.
